Dear Parent:
The Calloway County Preschool Student Assistance Team, or SAT, is a school-based group of teachers, administrators, and other school specialists. The purpose of the SAT is to provide additional support for students who are having academic or behavior difficulties that are impacting their school performance. Interventions are provided in a "tiered" model. Tier 1 provides general screening and a research-based core instructional program for all students within the regular classroom setting. Tier 2 is designed to provide supplementary intervention through early identification and assistance for a small percentage of students who are experiencing academic and/or behavioral problems. Tier 3 (intensive) interventions are for students who do not make adequate progress following Tier 2 interventions and need more individualized assistance. If students make sufficient progress in Tier 2 interventions, he/she will be dismissed from the Kentucky System of Interventions (KSI) program. If a student demonstrates progress at the Tier 3 level, s/he may return to the Tier 2 interventions. Should your child not demonstrate progress at the Tier 3 level, you may be contacted regarding a possible referral for an individual evaluation. (See attached description of the district policies regarding KSI procedures, performance data and strategies.)
